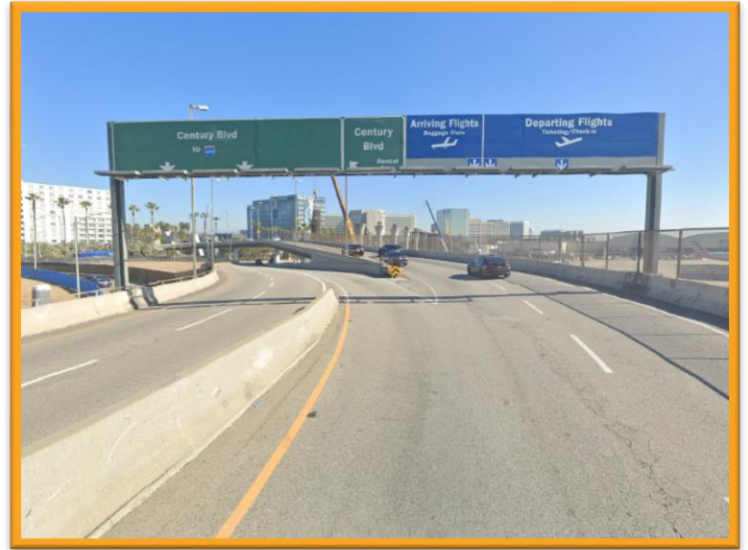

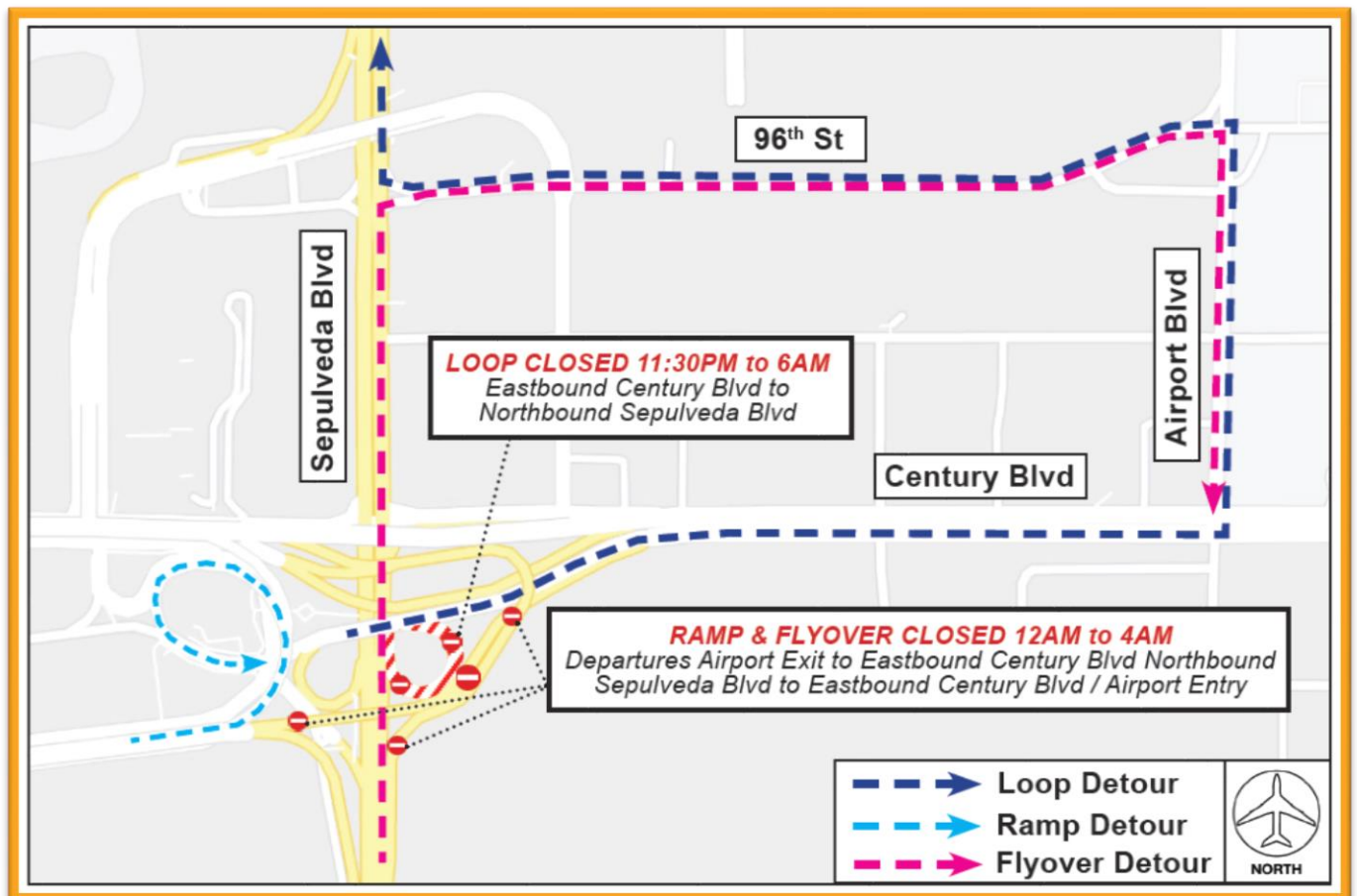

1. Airport Entry / Exit Lane Restrictions

- Work for the Automated People Mover project that closes the East Loop (eastbound Century Boulevard to northbound Sepulveda Boulevard loop) has been extended through Fri. 2/4/22, nightly from 11:30PM to 6AM
- Additionally, the Departures Airport Exit to eastbound Century Boulevard and northbound Sepulveda Boulevard ramp to eastbound Century Boulevard / Airport Entry Flyover nightly closure has also been extended through Fri. 2/4/22, nightly from 12AM to 4AM

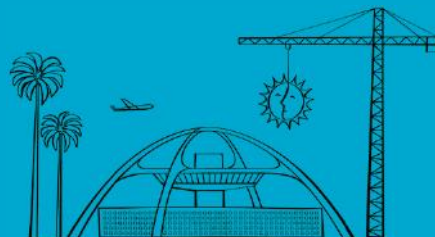


Ramps to eastbound Century Boulevard / Airport Entry Flyover

2. Terminal 3: Pedestrian Bridge

- Work to construct a Pedestrian Bridge between Terminal 3 and a future APM CTA Station was completed last week with all steel trusses successfully installed over the course of four nights
- Lane restrictions will remain in place on the Arrivals Level until mid-February when the shoring tower (yellow structure pictured below) is removed and a traffic signal is re-installed
- The completion of this structure officially marks the half way point for installation of APM Pedestrian Bridges, a major milestone for the modernization of LAX
- Work on the next Pedestrian Bridge at the Terminal 1.5 area is scheduled to begin next month; watch Construction Hot Topics for updates



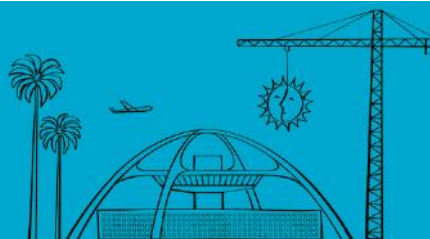
A 97,000 pound steel truss is lifted into place at Terminal 3 with the help of a 350-ton crane

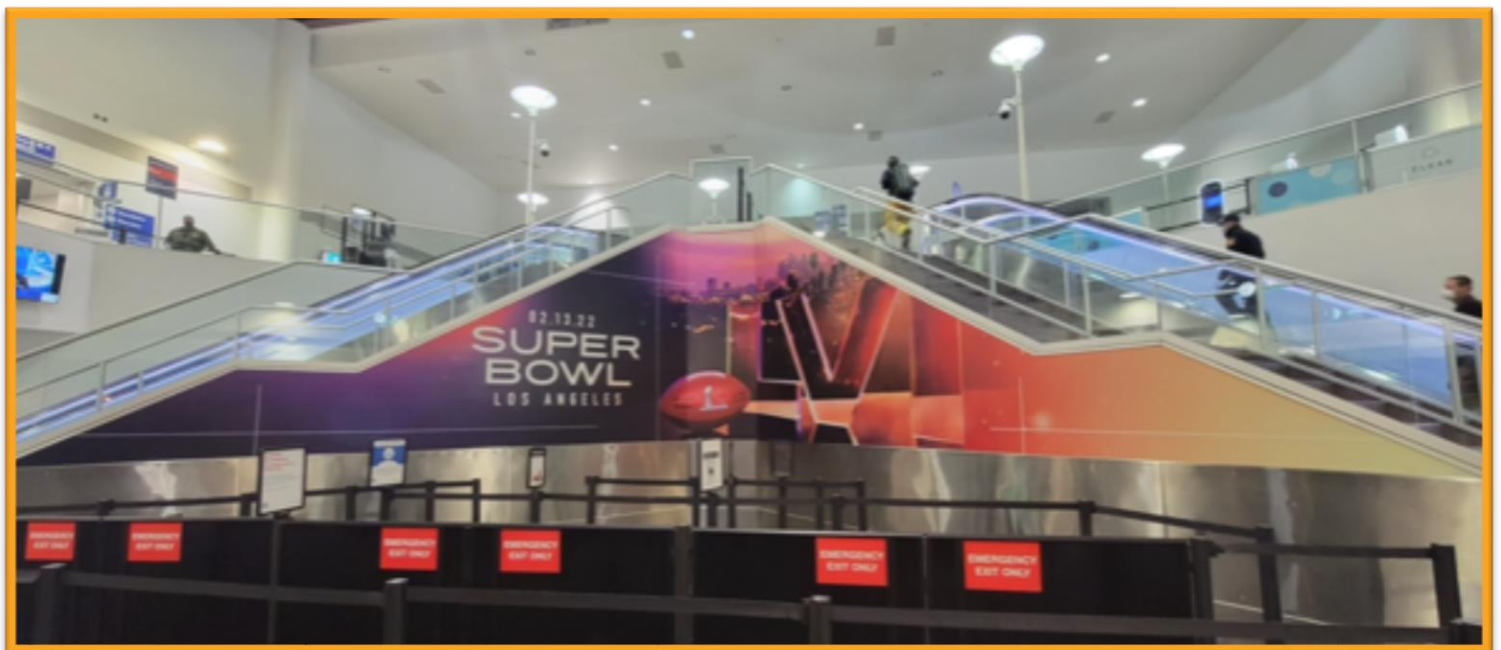
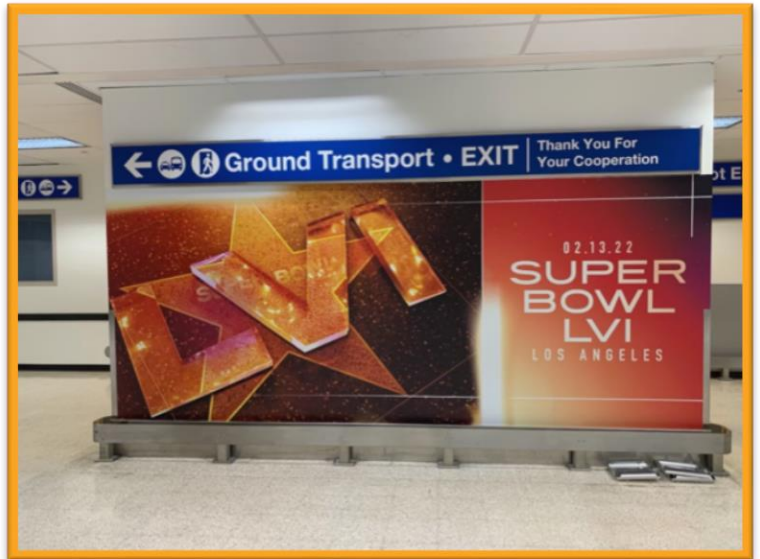

3. Super Bowl Graphics & Construction Moratoriums

- The 2022 Super Bowl will be held in Los Angeles on Sunday, February 13
- Keep an eye out in our terminals, on our construction barricades, and around the Central Terminal Area for new graphics installed to promote the big event, which will see a large influx of passengers pass through LAX
- To accommodate the increase in passenger and vehicular traffic, a Construction Moratorium will be in effect Thursday, February 10 at 6AM through Tuesday, February 15 at 6AM, limiting the types of impactful construction activity that can be performed during this time
