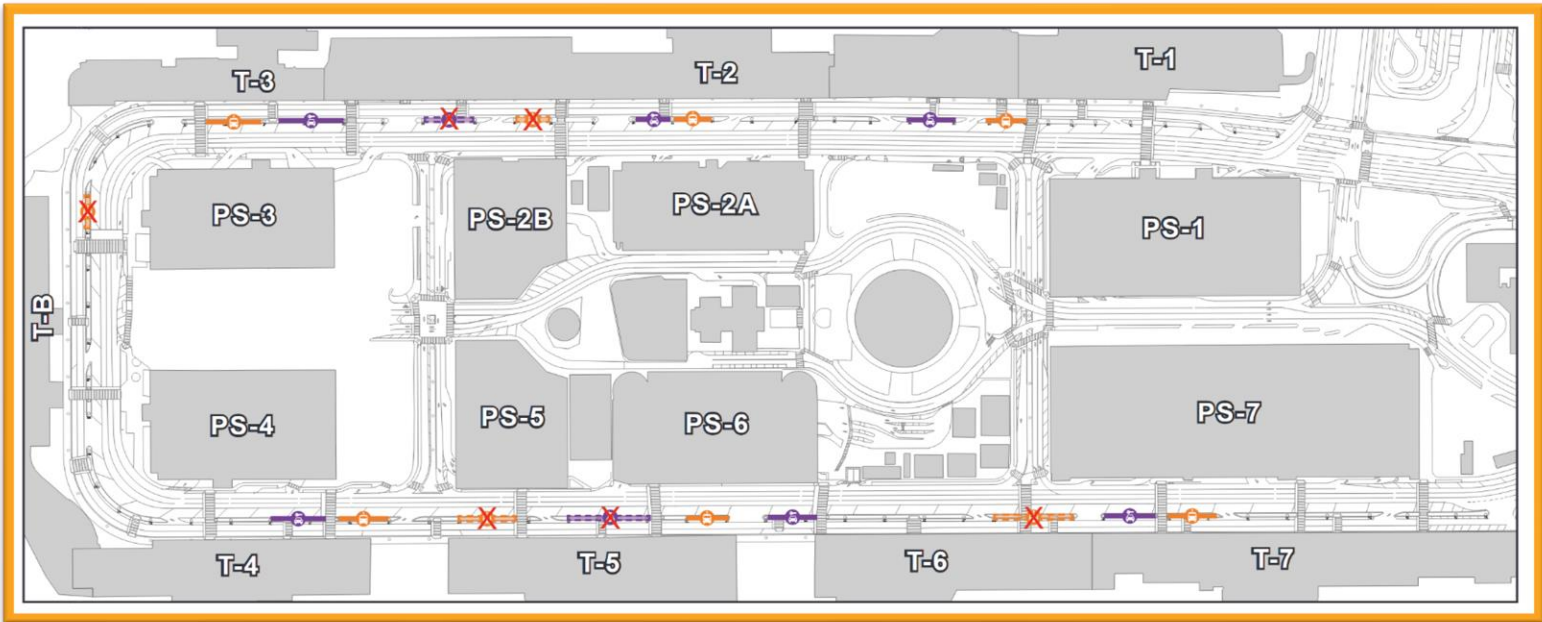


Construction Hot Topics

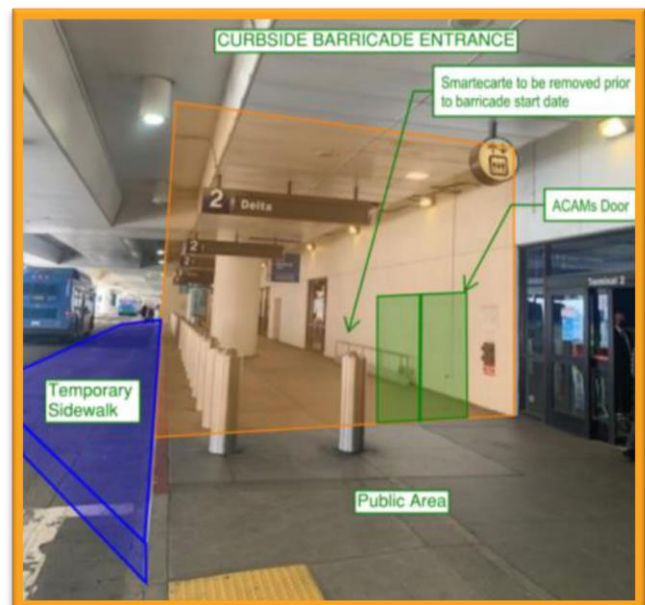
1. Changes to Arrivals Level Outer Curb Ground Transportation

- As a reminder, effective Friday, June 10 the Rental Car (purple) and Shared Ride Van / Charter Bus (orange) shuttle stops at Arrivals Level Outer Curbs have been updated per the map below
- Changes include the addition of new stops as well as the relocation or removal of some existing stops to better facilitate Ground Transportation operations
- All signage and maps have been updated to reflect the new locations throughout the Central Terminal Area



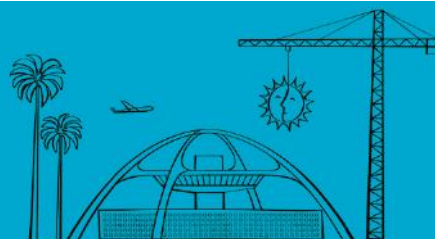
2. Terminal 2: Curbside Barricades

- On the Arrivals Level, curbside barricades are scheduled to be constructed this week per the diagram to the right beginning June 14 – 17 as part of the Delta Sky Way program
- Pedestrian access will be maintained via a temporary pedestrian sidewalk constructed over one inner drop off lane
- Motorists and pedestrians should follow posted detour signage and use caution when travelling near construction areas

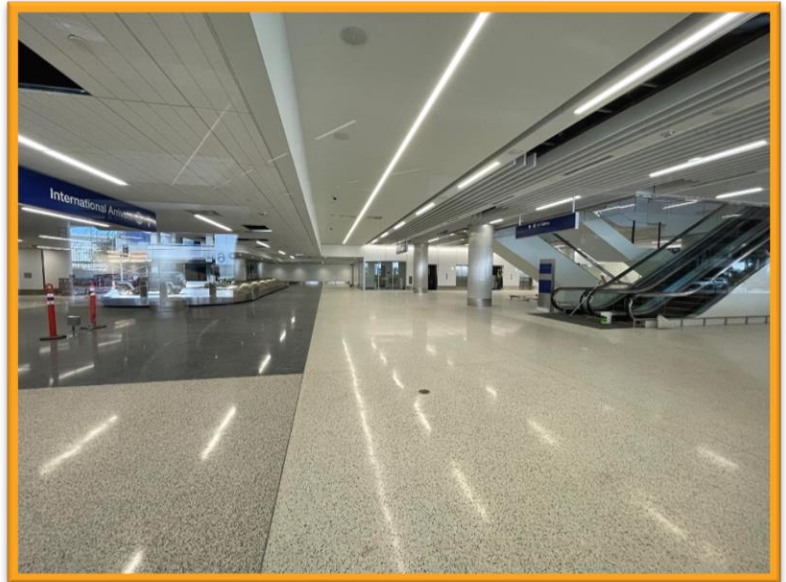

3. Terminal 5.5: Construction Update

- On the Arrivals Level, all curbside construction barricades have been removed and roadway lanes restored / reopened as part of the Terminal 5.5 Cores & APM Interface project
- This week, the Arrivals Level portion of the new terminal connector building between Terminals 5 and 6 is scheduled to open on Wednesday, June 15
- The Arrivals Level (Level 1) is the only level that will be open; there will be no elevator or escalator access to other levels at this time
- On the Departures Level, demolition of the temporary pedestrian sidewalk extension and canopy is scheduled for June 14 – 30, 2022
