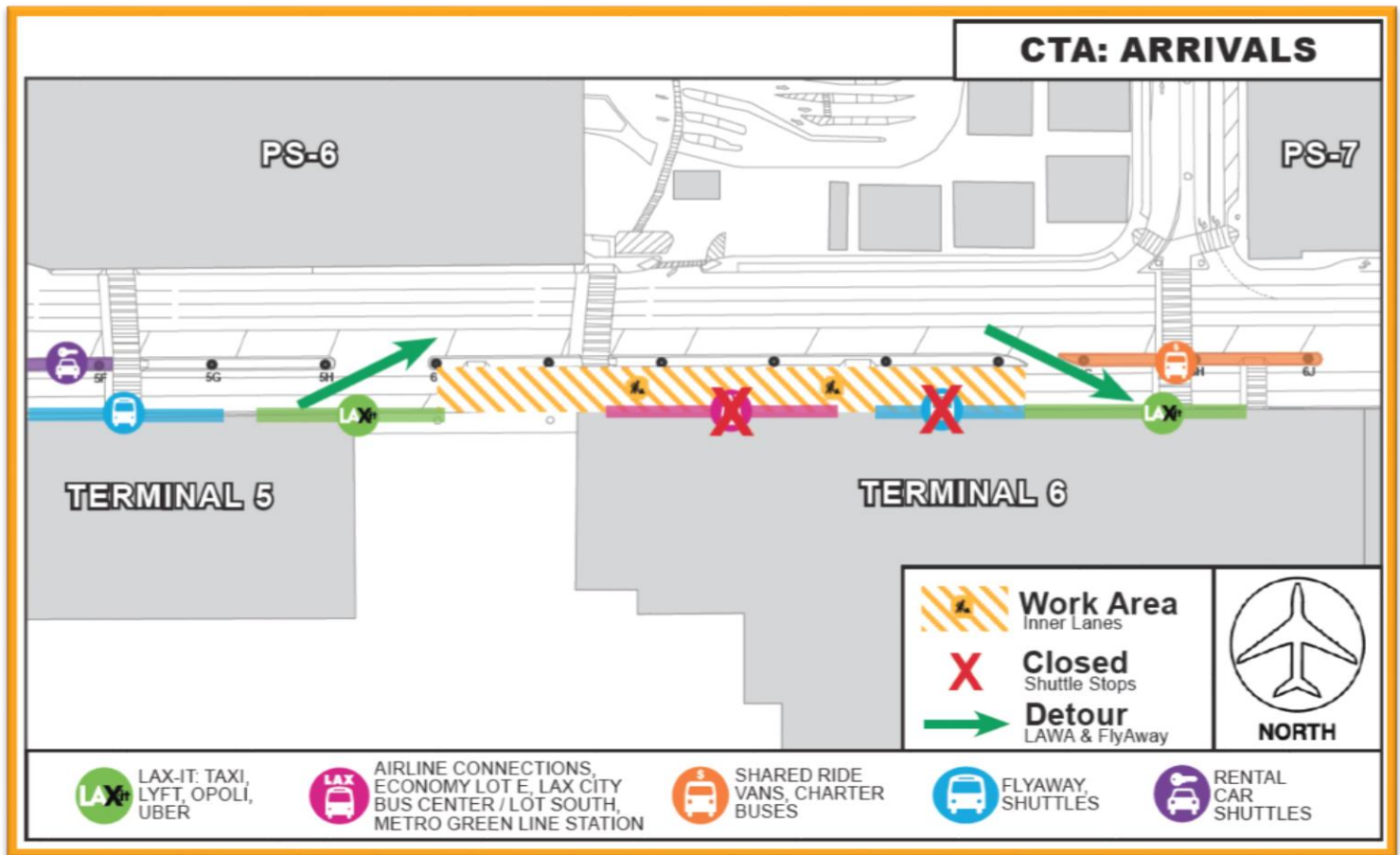


Construction Hot Topics

1. CTA Lane Restrictions: Arrivals Level Terminal 5.5

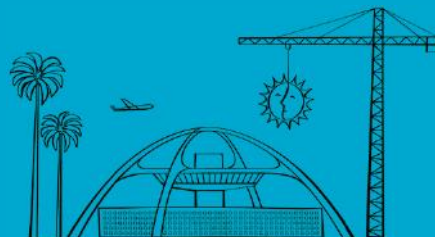
- Underground investigative work for the Terminal Cores and APM Interface project will have all Arrivals Level inner lanes between Terminals 5 and 6 closed through August 21, 2020 (from 12AM to 7AM only)
- Inner lane shuttles (LAWA, LAX-it and FlyAway) exit at Column 6A and re-enter at Column 6G
- Signage is in place guiding pedestrians to the next available shuttle stop as needed

- Pictured below, the exterior of the building is nearly complete

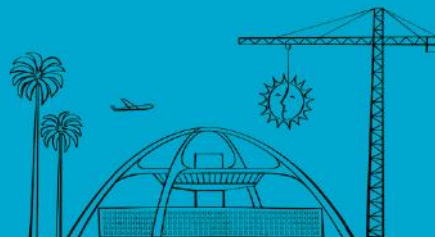


Top: Terminal 1.5 future Ticketing Level flooring

- The Airport Police Facility (APF) project recently completed its final concrete pour for the main building and adjacent parking structure
- The APF is scheduled to be complete in 2021; parking structure is scheduled to open late 2020
