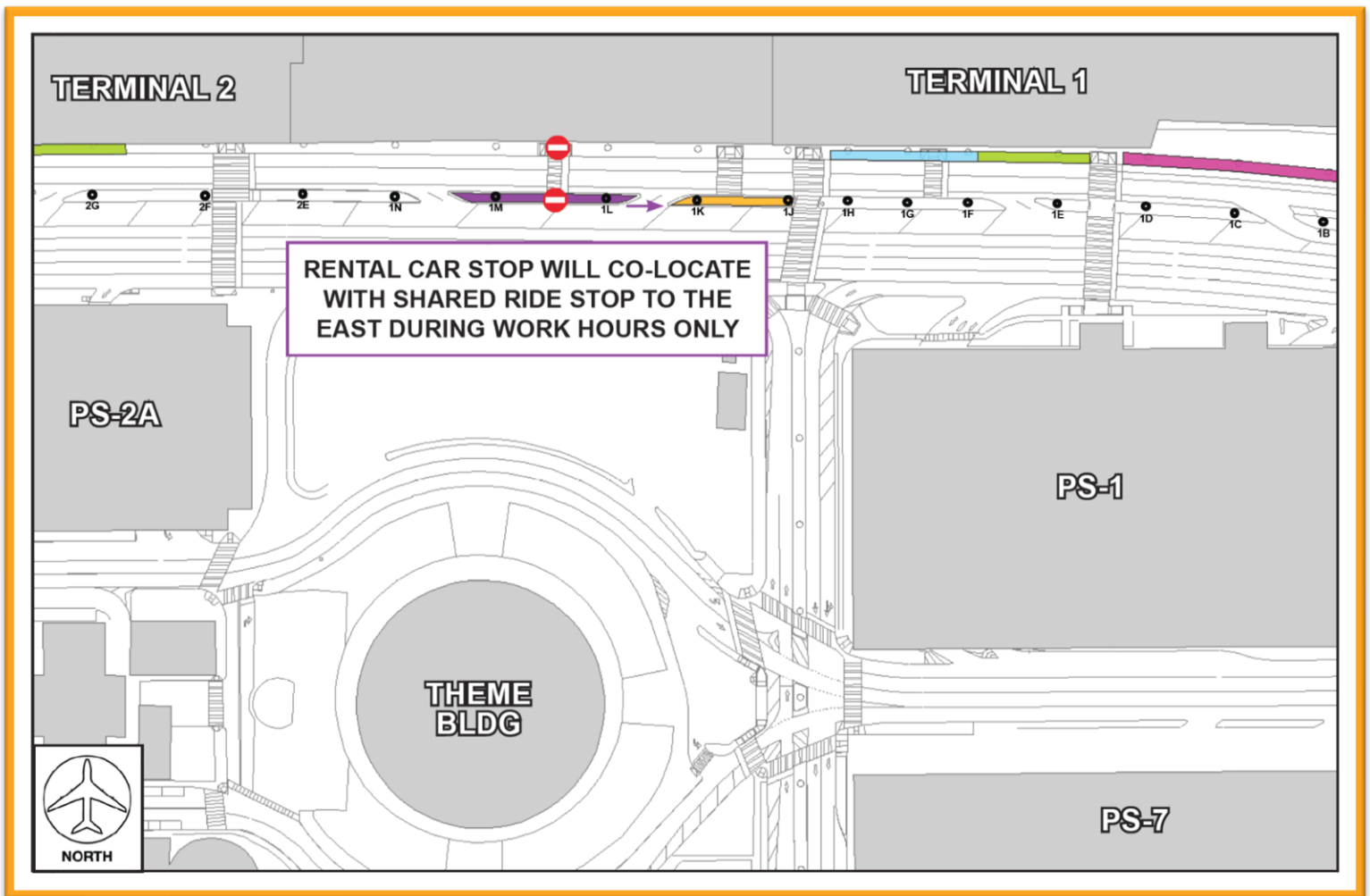


# Construction Hot Topics

## 1. Terminal 1: Nightly Shuttle Stop Impacts

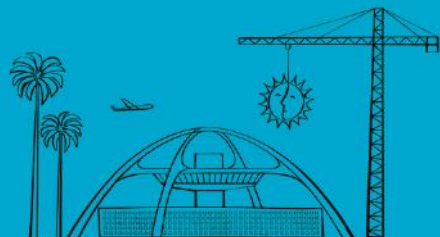
- To facilitate APM construction, the Rental Car Shuttle Stop (purple) at Terminal 1 will be relocated to the east to collocate with the existing Shared Ride Van & Charter Bus Shuttle Stop (orange) beginning October 26 through November 9, nightly from 1AM to 6AM
- The crosswalk to the closed Rental Car Shuttle Stop will be barricaded
- Signage will be in place to direct guests to the relocated stop



*The existing Rental Car stop will be relocated nightly to collocate with the Shared Ride Van & Charter Bus stop at Terminal 1 from 10/26 to 11/9 (1AM to 6AM only)*

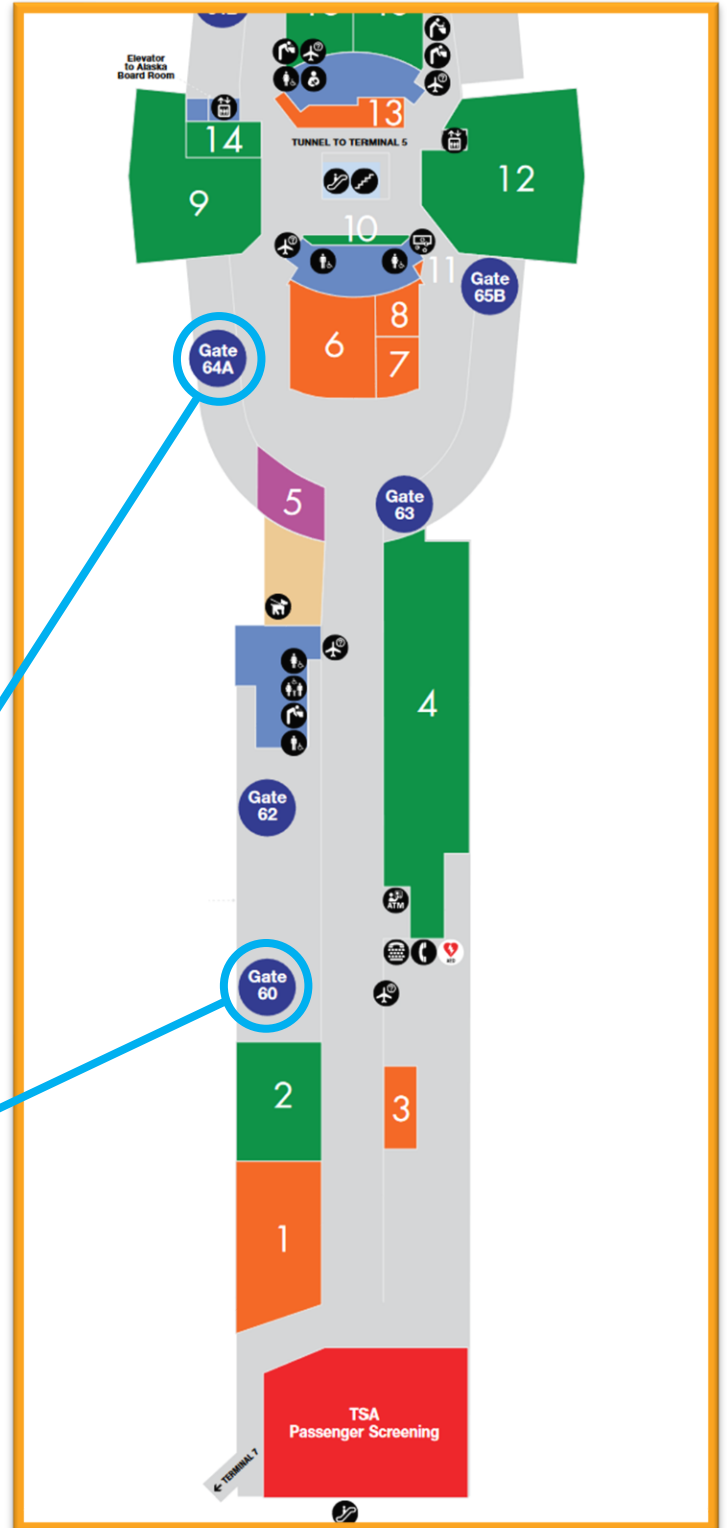

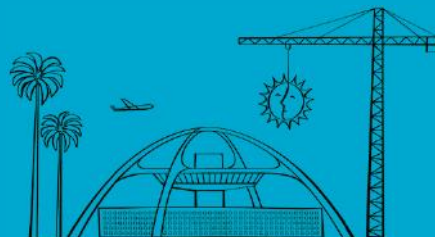
*Airline Gate 64A in Terminal 6 will re-open October 24, 2022*

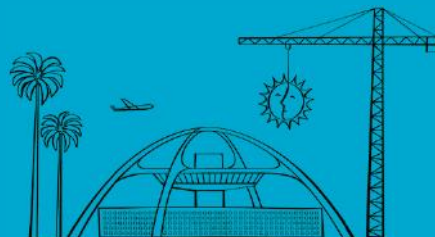
## 3. Sepulveda Boulevard Tunnel Cleaning

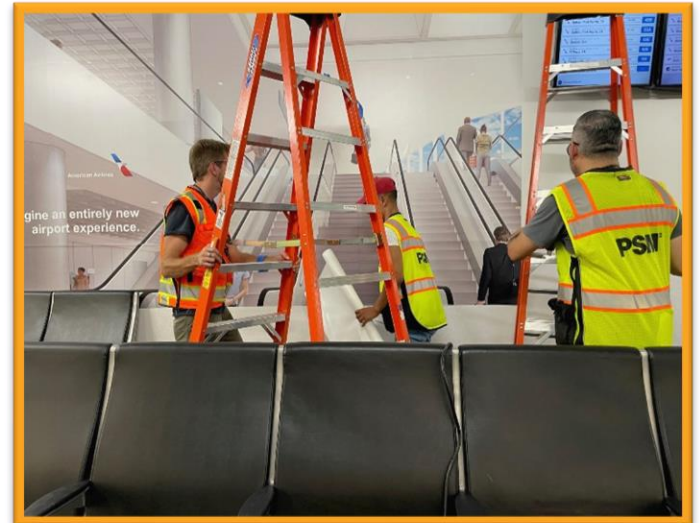
